ANALYSIS BREAKDOWN

SPAR continued its investment in the education of black people living with disabilities, with R1.8 million invested in such training in 2021, benefiting over 60 black learners.



Areas of improvement for SPAR:

- Skills Development, particularly bursaries for black people at institutions of higher learning
- Procurement, particularly procurement spend with suppliers that are black owned EME's and QSE's
- Supplier Development



SPAR showed an increase in the Ownership element in the 2021 financial period as compared to prior year, while there was a decrease in the remaining four elements.



SPAR contributed R53 million towards Enterprise Development and Supplier Development in the 2021 period



SPAR contributed a further R17 million towards Socio - Economic Development activities in the 2021 period.
